HELLO CHORIZO

A classic Spanish sausage spiced with paprika and garlic.

Start here

- Before starting, preheat the oven to 425°F.
- Wash and dry all produce.

Bust Out

Baking sheet, measuring spoons, parchment paper, 2 small bowls, large non-stick pan

Ingredients

Chorizo Sausage, uncased	250 g	500 g

Green Bell Pepper	200 g	400 g
Onion, sliced	113 g	226 g
Garlic Puree	1 tbsp	2 tbsp
Green Onions	2	4
Mayonnaise	4 tbsp	8 tbsp
Balsamic Vinegar	2 tbsp	4 tbsp
Parsley	7 g	14 g
Baby Tomatoes	113 g	227 g
Sugar*	1 tsp	2 tsp
Oil*		
Salt and Pepper*

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Roast potatoes

Cut **potatoes** into ½-inch pieces. Add **potatoes** and **½ tbsp oil** (dbl for 4 ppl), to a parchment-lined baking sheet. Season with **salt** and **pepper**, then toss to coat. Roast in the **middle** of the oven, flipping halfway through cooking, until golden-brown, 18-20 min.



Prep

While **potatoes** roast, core, then cut **pepper** into ½-inch pieces. Finely chop **parsley**. Thinly slice **green onions**. Stir together **mayo**, **half the parsley** and **¼ tsp garlic puree** (dbl for 4 ppl) in a small bowl. Set aside.



Caramelize onions

Heat a large non-stick pan over medium heat. When hot, add **½ tbsp oil** (dbl for 4 ppl), then **onions**. Cook, stirring often, until slightly softened, 2-3 min. Add **vinegar** and **1 tsp sugar** (dbl for 4 ppl). Season with **salt**. Cook, stirring occasionally, until dark golden-brown, 7-8 min. Remove pan from heat. Transfer **onions** to another small bowl and set aside. Carefully wipe the pan clean.



Cook chorizo

Heat the same pan over medium-high heat. When hot, add **½ tbsp oil** (dbl for 4 ppl), then **peppers**. Cook, stirring occasionally, until softened, 3-4 min. Add **chorizo** and **remaining garlic puree**. Cook, breaking up **chorizo** into smaller pieces, until no pink remains, 3-5 min. ** Season with **salt** and **pepper**.



Finish and serve

Add **roasted potatoes**, **tomatoes**, **half the green onions** and **remaining parsley** to the pan with **chorizo**. Stir to combine. Divide **hash** between bowls and top with **caramelized onions**. Dollop with **parsley aioli** and sprinkle over **remaining green onions**.



Got eggs?!

In step 4, while **chorizo** cooks, heat a medium non-stick pan over medium-low heat. When hot, add **2 tbsp butter** (dbl for 4 ppl) and swirl pan, until melted. Crack in **two eggs** (dbl for 4 ppl). Season with **salt** and **pepper**. Pan-fry, covered, until **egg whites** are set, 2-3 min. ** Top **chorizo hash** with a **fried egg** before serving. (NOTE: The yolks will still be runny!)
